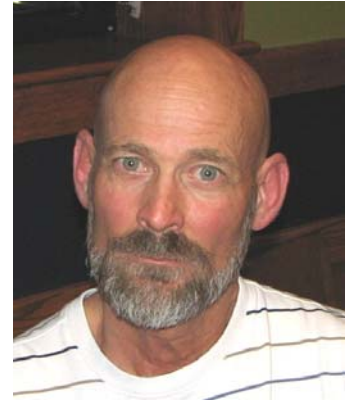
Why am I telling you all this?

Ralph Alger, 86, N4MQR and former MARA member, passed away peacefully in his sleep early Tuesday morning, Nov. 23. Ralph was born in Rockingham County on Nov. 2, 1924. He served in Civilian Public Service at Powellsville, Md., and in North Carolina during World War II. He also served two to three years in Mennonite Voluntary Service at Calling Lake, Alberta, Canada, as a bush pilot. He graduated from Eastern Mennonite College in 1954. In 1968, he received a certification in electronics from Northern Alberta Technical Institute, Edmonton, Alberta, Canada. Upon completing his electrical engineering degree, he returned to Virginia to help get WVPT-TV on the air. He then worked for Worrell Productions, WHSV-TV as senior staff engineer until his retirement in 1989. His hobbies were flying air-planes and glider planes, sailing while in St. Thomas, and riding a bike for exercise. He especially enjoyed spending time on his ham radio, talking to local friends or other operators around the world. A memorial service was conducted on Saturday, Dec. 18, 2010, at Zion Mennonite Church located in Broadway.

**146.625 - 131.8 PL**

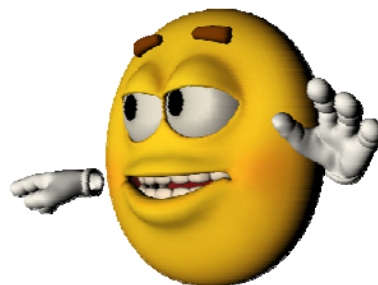
